

What is legacy work?

No matter the stage, a cancer diagnosis often forces us to think about our legacy and what we may leave behind to our loved ones when the time comes. Sometimes these thoughts are practical and pragmatic, and other times these thoughts are more existential or intangible. Often, these thoughts remain just as those, thoughts.

What if you had the opportunity to take those thoughts about what you would like to leave to your loved ones and actually make it tangible? Would you consider it? Does it feel overwhelming to you?

The good news is that turning these thoughts into something tangible doesn't have to be a big project. It can be something as simple as writing a family recipe down in your handwriting or telling some of your favorite memories (either writing them down or creating an audio file), or recording a storybook for a grandchild.

Legacy work is the process of sitting down and purposefully transforming thoughts into action. Specifically, it is about transforming the memories that your loved ones have of you into something tangible that will be something of comfort for them in the future.

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Legacy Project: Family Recipes

Are your fondest memories of preparing Sunday dinners or baking cookies from a recipe passed down through generations? Write down your favorite recipe with all those secret ingredients so your loved ones can continue and remember you fondly as they prepare and enjoy delicious foods.

Are you a little bit of this, and a "little bit of that" kind of person? No problem, make that delicious meal while someone is there to record all your pinches and dashes; then transcribe it to the recipe card as you savor the flavor of your creation.





Legacy Project: Recording Moments

Is your wedding song "unforgettable in every way," or do you have a favorite saying, quote, scripture verse or story?

Use these voice recordings to capture your voice or a song then place the device behind a picture frame to serenade your loved one back to the most wonderful days of your life as they look upon the photo adoringly.

You can also place it in a pillow or the paw of a teddy bear so your loved one can physically hold onto something that reminds them of you as you recite the top 10 things off the endless list of reasons you love them.

Record anything you'd like to share. The sweet voice that plays over and over in your loved one's head can become more tangible and shared with others.



Legacy Project: Greeting Cards


Handwritten cards with your words of wisdom or messages of love are an easy way for your loved ones to feel your presence on milestone occasions or even "just because," even after you are gone.

Choose cards for your loved ones to receive for special occasions from you either a little while from now or years into the future. Imagine your child (or grandchild) receiving a card from you before they walk down the aisle or receiving some of your words of wisdom as they become a parent for the first time. Send your spouse your love on their birthday, Valentine's Day, or your best friend congratulations on their retirement.

Address the envelopes and put stamps on them and give them to a trusted friend or family member to send out as you wish.

Legacy Project: Fingerprint Memories

A fingerprint project is a creative way to build a connection between you and your loved ones by creating a lasting token or memento with your fingerprints. This project can be done solo or with adults or children to feel connected to them through this project.

Here are instructions to get you started. Choose between clay or ink and paper or both!

Fingerprint with Clay

- Roll a small ball of air-dry clay, then flatten it slightly but not too thin so it doesn't easily snap when it dries
- Press one (or more) of your fingers into the clay to make an impression of your finger(s)
- Use a pencil or pen to make a small hole to turn it into an ornament or leave it without a hole to keep it as a memento to hold or keep in a pocket
- Allow to fully air dry before adding optional ribbon or color or words with paint or markers
- Give the token to someone who wants to feel connected to you no matter where you are

Fingerprint with Ink

- Press your finger(s) firmly on an ink pad avoid using washable ink to preserve longevity
- Thumbs often work best.
- Starting with one side of your finger, roll and press your fingerprint onto cardstock or paper. We suggest doing it a few times to pick the cleanest print.
- Snap a picture to create a digital image that can be saved, emailed, shared, or turned into something creative



Creative Ideas to Turn Your Fingerprint Art Into

Several online companies turn digital fingerprint images into tangible items like metal stones, necklaces, charms, keychains etc. Visit Etsy to view options - etsy.com/market/fingerprint_jewelry or search for "fingerprint mementos" online

With a flat marble, use Mod Podge glue to affix the fingerprint onto the bottom of the flat marble to create a stone that is easy to keep in a pocket and squeeze in your palm. Add an extra layer of Mod Podge on the bottom to help hold the print in place.



Search for "kid fingerprint art" to get ideas on turning fingerprints into animals, trees, or other designs. This is a great project to do with children. You could even create a heart by overlapping your fingerprint with someone else's fingerprint.
